



The Chevron Championship 2026 Volunteer Committee Descriptions

Admissions/Ticketing

Volunteers will be stationed at the tournament entrances to scan and check tickets of all guests. Volunteers will also assist with any issues or questions regarding tickets. Members of this committee will welcome spectators and provide general information/directions during tournament week.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Thursday, April 23 – Sunday, April 26

Caddie Operations (Coded Committee)

This committee provides support to the LPGA caddies. Volunteers will assist with LPGA caddie registration, professional caddie bib/towel distribution and cleaning, maintain the caddie lounge area, and act as a concierge for the caddies.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Sunday, April 19 – Sunday, April 26

Cart Management

Volunteers will manage the distribution and return of all golf carts. Assist with cart numbering and name plates, answer questions, and address cart maintenance issues throughout the day with the tournament's operations team. At the end of the day, ensure cart keys are returned, carts are charging, cleaned daily, and staged appropriately for easy access in the morning.

Age Requirement: 21+

Dates of Operation: Saturday, April 18 – Monday, April 27

Gallery Management

Gallery Management volunteers have a unique, inside-the-ropes role in directing the flow of spectator and player traffic. Volunteers are responsible for managing gallery noise level, ensuring player safety and efficient movement around the golf course, and providing exceptional

guest experience. Volunteers will also locate balls that go outside of the ropes in areas where there are no spotters and control the stake and rope when either component interferes with a player's swing.

Gallery Management Ambassadors are assigned to the tee box, fairway and green of a specific hole (1-18), or to high traffic areas such as practice locations, crosswalks, and hospitality areas.

Age Requirement: 16+

Dates of Operation: Thursday, April 23 – Sunday, April 26

Hospitality

Volunteers will be assigned to one of the hospitality venues/areas to welcome patrons and guests in secure hospitality areas. Volunteers will monitor entrances to the hospitality venues and ensure that only those with proper credentials/tickets are allowed in each specific area.

Volunteers will also assist answering any patron questions.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Thursday, April 23 – Sunday, April 26

Media (Coded Committee)

Assist The Chevron Championship Tournament staff and LPGA Tour media officials in the Championship Media Center with roles including media registration, basic administrative needs, distributing Tournament and LPGA Tour information, player information support, answering general questions and providing support to credentialed media.

Age Requirement: 21+

Dates of Operation: Monday, April 20 – Sunday, April 26

Merchandise

Volunteers will assist the Tournament Staff in stocking and selling merchandise in the official merchandise tent. Volunteers will help unpack, hang, and price merchandise prior to tournament week. During tournament week, volunteers will manage registers (training to be offered), provide customer service, and help keep the tent stocked and clean. Volunteers must be comfortable standing for several hours and handling transactions on the registers with a friendly customer-service attitude.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Advance week date TBD – Sunday, April 26

On-Course Services

During tournament week, the primary focus of the volunteers will be distribution of water, ice, and other supplies for the players, caddies, volunteers, and various special events. The requirements for this committee are the ability to lift 35 lbs. and drive a flatbed golf cart. Volunteers must be prepared for all weather conditions.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Sunday, April 19 – Monday, April 27

Parking Services

Volunteers will help direct spectators, VIPs, volunteers, vendors, and media to park off-site and assist getting on shuttles to the entrance. Volunteers may also be responsible for driving golf cart shuttles taking VIPs from on-site lots to the main entrance.

Age Requirement: 21+ (with valid driver's license)

Dates of Operation: Sunday, April 19 – Sunday, April 26

Player Services (Coded Committee)

Volunteers will act as a concierge to LPGA athletes. This committee works closely with the Transportation Committee. Volunteers will also assist with LPGA player registration, vehicle assignments, manage player dining and hospitality area access, and assist with distributing player packages to the locker room.

Age Requirement: 21+ (female only)

Dates of Operation: Sunday, April 19 – Sunday, April 26

Practice Areas

Volunteers on this committee will oversee the operations (including daily set-up and break-down) of the practice facility including the driving range and chipping green. Volunteers will be responsible for setting up name plates for players, sorting golf balls, filling range buckets, and marshalling the chipping green. This committee will have early mornings and late evenings.

Age Requirement: 16+

Dates of Operation: Sunday, April 19 – Sunday, April 26

Scoring Control

Volunteers will support the management of the LPGA's scoring system in scoring trailer. You will work closely with the Walking Scorers and the LPGA's official scoring vendor throughout the week. Requires mandatory training during week of tournament and computer/technology proficiency.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Tuesday, April 21; Thursday, April 23 – Sunday, April 26

Shipping and Receiving

Volunteers will be stationed at the tournament's shipping and receiving area and will ensure that all packages are distributed to the Tournament Staff, Player Services committee, Golf Channel/Media, etc. This committee will require some heavy lifting as packages arrive in different sizes. This position will work outside, and volunteers must be prepared for all weather conditions. There may be times when this committee waits in the receiving area for packages to arrive.

Age Requirement: 21+

Dates of Operation: Sunday, April 19 – Sunday, April 26

Special Events and Fan Engagement

Volunteers will assist with special events and on-course activations during advance and tournament week. This committee will be responsible for welcoming players and participants, registration, distribution of participant gifting, golf bag staging, score card collection, and other duties related to the operations of the Junior Legacy Pro-Am and the Official Pro-Am. During the tournament, volunteers will work with guests and vendors in special fan areas such as the Inspiration Dome and the Chip for Charity activation. Experience with elite customer service is preferred and professional appearance and attitude are required.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Sunday, April 19 – Sunday, April 26

Standard Bearers (Coded Committee)

Volunteers will follow a group of golfers during their round of play, inside the ropes. Your primary responsibility will be to show the gallery who is playing in the group and to display their scores in relation to par on a cumulative basis by carrying a standard sign presenting that information. A basic understanding of golf scoring and golf etiquette is required. Shifts are outside and in direct sunlight and the elements. Volunteers must have the ability to walk 18 holes while carrying a 5-pound sign.

Age Requirement: 14+

Dates of Operation: Thursday, April 23 – Sunday, April 26

Transportation

Volunteers will assist with the pick-up and return of golf professionals and management staff to both Houston Hobby and Bush International airports. May be asked to drive players, family members, and other VIPs to and from hotels and other destinations. Volunteers will also assist with inventory, inspection, staging, and deployment of courtesy cars and the collection, inspection, and staging of cars at the end of the tournament.

Age Requirement: 25+

Must provide a valid US driver's license. Background check will also be required.

Dates of Operation: Friday, April 17 – Sunday, April 26

TV/Broadcast

Volunteers must have extensive golf knowledge. Volunteers will be trained by a media representative to understand what the TV Truck will be asking of a volunteer walking or driving alongside a certain group of players. Volunteers will have a radio and earpiece to communicate player shot information with the TV truck throughout the round. Volunteers may be asked to help spot where each shot lands and report back to the TV Truck.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Thursday, April 23 – Sunday, April 26

Volunteer Services

Volunteers may assist with the inventory and assembly of volunteer uniform packages and help distribute packages on scheduled distribution/training days. During tournament week, volunteers will manage the volunteer tent, manage volunteer check-in and ensure only credentialed

volunteers are entering the tent, answer questions, exchange/sell uniforms, and maintain the volunteer hospitality area by restocking food/beverage and keeping the area clean.

Age Requirement: 16+

Dates of Operation: Uniform Dist. Days TBD; Monday, April 20 – Sunday, April 26

Walking Scorers (Coded Committee)

The Walking Scorer role is a prestigious and critical volunteer position that requires mental and physical stamina, attention to detail, and a thorough understanding of the game of golf.

Volunteers must have the ability to keep pace with their group across 18 holes without a break and in varying weather conditions.

The Walking Scorer accompanies a group of up to three players using a handheld tablet/computer to keep score, track specific statistics, and capture real-time data. Walking Scorers will also carry a voice radio and headset for communication with the LPGA scoring truck. Volunteers will be responsible for partnering with the Standard Bearer assigned to their grouping and are expected to assist Standard Bearers in being in the right places on tee boxes and greens. A mandatory online training session will be provided for review and a mandatory instructional session prior to the tournament start date. On-site support will also be provided.

Must work Tuesday Official Pro-Am to become familiar with course and equipment.

Age Requirement: 18+

Dates of Operation: Tuesday, April 21; Thursday, April 23 – Sunday, April 26
